## Is security important to customers?

## Another Example:

- Northeast manufacturing firm loses \$1 Billion contract, because competitor broke into its network of Unix Workstations and learned what it planned to bid (Information Week, 10/24/94):
  - Intrusion detected only after the fact by processing audit trail data.
  - By the time it was detected, the company had already lost the bid.

## Is security important to customers?

Yes. Here is an example why:

- MCI loses estimated \$50M due to insider attack against network communications (USA Today, 10/4/94):
  - Switch Technician modified switch software to gather more than 60,000 calling card numbers.
  - Calling card numbers were not only those from MCI, but also those from Sprint and AT&T, which routed their calls through MCI.


#### ■ GSSAPI

- Both Open Vision and Cybersafe sell versions of GSSAPI/KerbV5 for Unix.
- Cybersafe sells a version of GSSAPI/KerbV5 for MS Windows.
- MIT is working on GSSAPI interface to Kerberos V5 for MS Windows and Macintosh - due out this summer.
- Kerberos V5 KDC
  - Both Open Vision and Cybersafe sell KDCs along with administration tools.
