- 100 m or 300 m MMF
- Copper Not Defined Yet. Cat. 6
   Proposed
- LAN & WAN
- Rate Adaptation of 10 Gbps WAN to 9.58 Gbps OC-192 SONET
- Supports Link Aggregation/Trunking

#### IEEE 802.3ae

- IEEE 802 Plenary Meeting in Kauai Approved Project Authorization Request (PAR) on November, 1999
- Formed 802.3ae Task Force for 10 GE
- Objectives to Preserve Ethernet Frame Format & Size
- Technology Demo Prior to Standard Approval
- Major Challenge in PHY Selection



### IEEE 802.3ae Timeline

- 3/99: Call For Interest (Kick-Off)
- 11/99: Project Authorization Request (PAR) Approved
- 1/00 802.3ae Task Force Formed
- 7/00: Last New Proposal
- 5/01: Last Technical Change
- 3/02: Standard Approved



#### Interim Solution

- Sun Trunking Software Available Now
- Aggregates 2 GE Links or 8 FE Links
- IEEE 802.3ad Link Aggregation Standard to be Ratified on March, 2000
